Pioneers of sparkling wine from California's Sonoma Carneros region, Gloria Ferrer Caves & Vineyards has nurtured a dynamic relationship of discovery with the land for more than 20 years. In 1982, the Ferrer family—owners of the Catalan-based sparkling wine house Freixenet—purchased a cattle ranch in Sonoma Carneros, and planted vineyards with the traditional sparkling wine grapes of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

Today, Gloria Ferrer cultivates 385 acres of Carneros vineyard land for its ultra-premium sparkling and still wines. The winery is distinguished by a commitment to the highest quality fruit nurtured in hand-tended vineyards that result in balanced wines of expressive terroir and varietal character.

A memorable highlight of any visit to Gloria Ferrer is the Vista Terrace. A sun-drenched veranda overlooking the estate's picturesque vineyards, the Vista Terrace is one of the most dramatic architectural features at the winery, and an ideal spot for guests to enjoy a glass of sparkling or still wine.

While Gloria Ferrer's wines are pure California, its culture is a charismatic blend of vibrant Spanish tradition with casual California elegance. The winery itself, named after the owner's wife, is a harmonious marriage of Spanish and California mission design, built to reflect the architecture of the Ferrers' native Catalonia.
